



**AGA – Topeka Chapter  
Executive Committee Meeting Minutes  
February 1, 2006  
Rendezvous Restaurant, Topeka, Kansas**

Meeting was called to order at the Rendezvous, Topeka, Kansas, at 5:35 p.m. with a quorum present.

Sabrina Wells discussed the next lecture series on February 9 and the conflict with the ASTRA meeting. Wells suggested that attendance at the PDC Lecture Series might be lower than usual because of the conflict and informed Committee members that she would review current reservations to the Lecture Series and report back to the committee whether the February 9 lecture series with Senator Morris would be rescheduled or held as scheduled.

Wells reported that she would distribute the membership survey. It was agreed that this survey should be distributed after the February 2006 PDC. Wells noted that it might cost AGA approximately \$10 to set-up this survey for electronic response by participants.

Shirley Hollis reported that Topeka AGA has approximately 81 members. Shirley will draft a proposal for a membership drive at the next meeting.

Marsha Pappen reported that she needed financial reports for points and that the Chapter was lacking in points for some areas.

Brandi Baer reported that newsletter was sent electronically today and Pam will provide some articles to Brandi on CGFM for the newsletter.

Bramdi reported on the PDC and that nametags had been ordered, approximately 80 people were registered, CPE forms would need to be completed, and Andy McKee would be providing entertainment for the hospitality room.

With no further business to conduct the meeting adjourned at 6:35 p.m.
