The Annual Race Against Breast Cancer was held at Washburn University on Saturday morning, September 18th. This year’s honorary chairperson was Ron Thornburgh, Secretary of State.

Our members assisted with pre-registrations and then early Saturday morning with the actual race events. Friday evening at 5:30, I was interviewed by a local Radio DJ, Rose of 107.7 and talked about AGA’s involvement and the importance of volunteering. *Our chapter provided in excess of 20 volunteer hours!*

The race consisted of 847 total participants: 232 runners, 504 walkers, and 49 survivors of Breast Cancer. RABC raised \$35,000 from this year’s event.

The money raised benefits approximately 400 women in Shawnee County and the surrounding counties who wouldn’t be able to pay for mammograms.

Many of those involved with the race memorialize or support relatives and friends that are battling breast cancer.
